

Dent United Methodist Leadership Meeting

The regular meeting of the DUMC Leadership Team was held on Wednesday, July 30, at 3:00 pm.

Members present: Pastor Joyce, Doris Champlin, Austin Holtz, Karen Johnson and Ivy Mickelson.

A Zoom presentation was given by Phil with Edward Jones in regards to our investment. We have this set up for long-term usage with 50% being in fixed income investments and 50% in the equity sector. At this time, it appears there is less than an average chance of volatility before the end of the year.

Devotions and a prayer were given by Pastor Joyce.

Minutes: These were tabled as we didn't have a copy at our meeting.

Finance: Ivy reported that bills had been paid. No questions were asked. Karen made a motion to accept with a second from Austin. Approved.

Old Business:

- We discussed the items that need to be cleared up by 9-5-25 for Grinnell Mutual insurance after the inspection was done this spring.
- Roger and Robbie replaced the batteries in the security lights that weren't working. Roger and Robbie, also, replaced the bulbs in the exit signs.
- Austin contacted a company to examine our fire extinguishers.
- The remaining item is getting a water leak sensor installed in the utility room/kitchen area. Lyndon has the form, and Austin will work with him to get the last one completed.

New Business:

- Pastor Joyce asked Austin to converse with Roger about the possibility of Roger using his truck and trailer for our parade entry. Pastor will work out a message for the trailer and print it out. We have some candy in the freezer and Karen will pick up 2 more bags.
- The Bake Sale will be held at the Community Center with plans to set up the day before.
- Ivy brought up that our church listing in the Perham Focus is outdated. Austin will send the wording that is in Pelican Rapids newspaper to Ivy and Ivy will contact the Focus to get it updated.
- The spaghetti supper that was tentatively set for September was discussed. Austin made a motion with a second by Ivy to cancel our fall spaghetti supper.

Pastor's Report:

- Pastor Joyce reported that she was asked to and will be mentoring a group of pastors in the area for the next year.
- She will also be going to or meeting with somebody from the Frazee UMC to bless the elements, as they currently have no pastor.
- She also reported that she does not plan to retire until 2028 and hopes to continue to serve our parish.

Trustees Report:

Austin reported that we have been having an ant problem in the utility room. He has sprayed the garbage can back there and the floor area and they appear to be gone. We will be more diligent about removing the garbage promptly to lessen the issue.

A motion to adjourn was made by Austin, seconded by Karen.

Secretary Report

The minutes of the June meeting were approved as distributed.

Treasurer Report

The Treasurer report was accepted as handed out pending audit. Faye stated that she will cash the CD due this summer to pay for the construction costs and will do this out of the general fund.

Trustee Report

David reported that the fire alarm system is disconnected and should no longer be alarmed.

Pastor Report:

- Pastor Joyce reported that VBS needed to be cancelled due to conflicts of dates with the volunteers.
- Pastor Joyce was asked about her retirement plans and said that she is going to delay retirement until 2028. There will likely be no change before that date in the current arrangement.
- Joyce has been asked to mentor new pastors in the system.

Mission

- The approved \$10,000 to send to the churches in California was sent, and a nice letter of gratitude was received from the churches that were helped.
- Since VBS was cancelled due to a lack of volunteers, the June dollars are now available again. Tonya suggested we send local mission dollars to the schools to help with providing school supplies. Jane made a motion to take June, July and August local dollars and send \$300 to Frazee/Vergas School, Pelican Rapids School, and Perham School for them to purchase school supplies for the fall, seconded by Sheri and approved.
- Tonya reported on a new parenting class starting in Pelican Rapids, she discussed this with the Social Worker who was trained in the program from the Circle of Security International which is helping new mothers. She will remain in contact with this person, and we can consider this as a mission later.

Looney Days

- Planning is happening in the Church Ladies and Men's Group for Looney Day activities.
- Plans for a joint church service were cancelled.

Day Care Use of Church

Faye received an update from the EDA meeting, which was attached to the agenda. Everything is in pause until dollars can be obtained. Faye also shared an article from the newspaper, attached to official minutes.

Computer Upgrade

Sheri reported that Jody has the information on the new computers and needs to pick them up in Minneapolis. Sheri will coordinate with Joyce.

Arrowlift Service Agreement

Faye said that she received a request from Arrowlift for chair inspection and maintenance for \$848. Jane talked to Connie who said that it should not be that much. The State inspects them once every 3 years and we only need a once-a-year contract. Faye will follow up with Arrowlift to discuss options.

Spring Work

Contracts are in place, and we are waiting for the contractors to come and do the work. Tonya will have Mark mention to the contractors that Looney Day week would not be a good time to start.

Community Meal

Joyce stated that we are signed up to provide the food on August 14th for the Thursday night event in Vergas. We need a sign-up sheet to help. This will be a free meal to Bless the Community. We will serve Hot dogs, Chips, and Beans. The event is from 5:30-7:30 pm, we will need to start at church around 4 pm. Joyce will try to find out approximately how many have been served to have an idea of amount to order. We will get the food from the Mercantile. No drinks will be offered. We will need to have a tent, tables, and chairs for workers. We can plug roasters in at Otter Coffee.

The meeting was adjourned and closed with members expressing gratitude.

The next meeting will be on August 20th in person at the Church.
